The Ojai Valley Garden Club was founded in 1926 by a group of women who wanted to maintain and further beautify the Ojai Valley. It was set up as a service organization rather than just a social club.

The OVGC has planted trees, established public gardens, landscaped schools and other community facilities, and provided scholarships to students pursuing related studies. In the past, it has also lobbied political groups to eliminate roadside billboards and to save the redwoods and oak trees.

Meetings are held on the 2nd Wednesday of each month starting in October at 10AM at Fisher Hall, 409 Topa Topa Drive, Ojai, and include a guest speaker of interest to club members.

In December, members gather at Chaparral Auditorium for a day of holiday wreath decorating. The sale of the Christmas wreaths provides funding for future beautification projects. Because of "Wreath Day," there is no formal meeting in December.

In April there is a garden tour and the Club ends its year with the May annual luncheon.

All members are required to participate in Wreath Day and a once-a-year Post Office flower arrangement. Other activities of club members are:

- *Hospitality at monthly meetings
- *Tea Tent florals at the Tennis Tournament
- *Serving as a Committee Chair or Board Member
